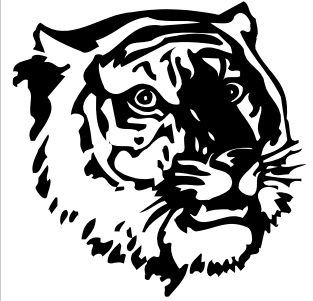


Ohio Improvement Process District Goals

GOAL 1: Students participating in state assessments will demonstrate an increase in **math** performance as evidenced by an increase in the number of math indicators met from 3 in 2008 [**NOW 5 in 2011**] to 8 by 2012.

GOAL 2: Students participating in state assessments will demonstrate an increase in **reading** performance as evidenced by an increase in the number of reading indicators met from 3 in 2008 [**NOW 6 in 2011**] to 8 by 2012.

GOAL 3: **Graduation Rate** will increase from 81.8% in 2008 [**NOW 85.4 in 2010**] to at least 90% by 2012 by implementing evidenced-based school climate strategies.
